01 C: Um, can I try a couple of the reds please?

05 C: I've tried the Gnangara Shiraz

06 S: yes

07 C: before, but not the Barrique 61.

08 S: The Barrique 61's sort of a, a new wine that they've been making. It's only got ten per cent Merlot in it and ninety per cent Cabernet, but e-, it's a nice soft ... It's got a, got a quite a bit of a nice body to it.

09 C: Oh, more the, () the sort of the traditional Bordeaux-type blend?

10 S: Yes

11 C: Yeah. Well, I haven't tried that, so I'd like to try

12 S: You haven't tried that one?

13 C: No, I've tried the Gnangara many times. Great wine.

14 S: Oh well, if you've tried that one, you then..., well try the ah, the Barrique 61 then.

15 C: Which do you reckon's the best comparison (I could) try with the Barrique? I mean what would be the closest?

16 S: Um, probably, er, oh, that's a good question there.

17 C: (Well) perhaps the Margaret River Cabernet, because that's a straight, straight

18 S: Cabernet

19 C: Cabernet.

20 S: But there's, also there's a straight Merlot too. Probably the Cabernet would be the closest one to it, yeah.

21 C: Mm.

[SERVER POURS WINE]

22 S: 'Cause M-, Merlot itself is a very soft wine.

23 C: (That's) got a lovely intense colour, hasn't it? [SNIFFS]

24 S: It's becoming quite a ni-, um, um, a good wine, this one, yeah.

25 C: Ooh! I think you (can) taste the wood. Yeah, how long have you had that one on the market? I haven't seen that before.

26 S: We've had this one on the market, it e-, it was released, um, late last year ().

27 C: Late last year? ()

28 S: It's actually the only second vintage of this wine.

29 C: And the grapes come from?

30 S: The grapes is actually coming from all the regions, the Mount Barker and, um, Margeter River, mm.
